

EUDR by Qarma

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The EU Deforestation Regulation (EUDR) requires companies to show that key products – wood, soy, palm oil, coffee, cocoa, rubber, and cattle – are deforestation-free and legally sourced.

This means new due diligence demands including geolocation tracing, risk assessment, mitigation, and reporting.

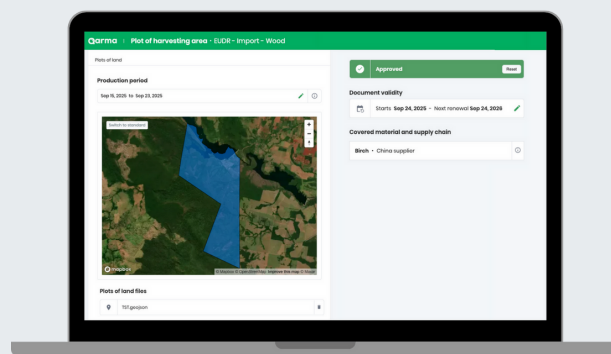

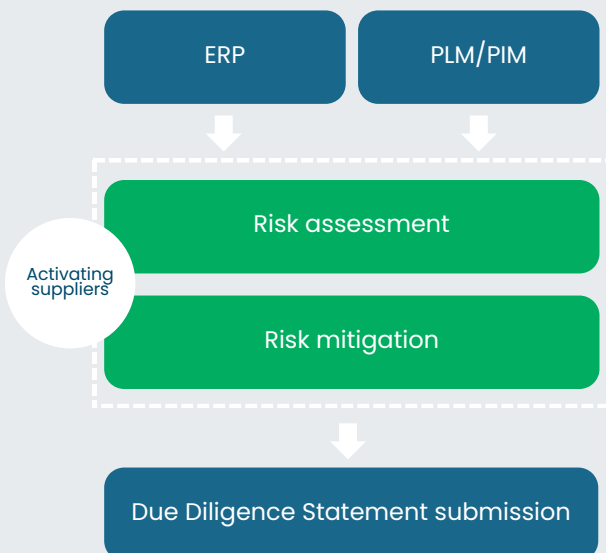

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is Qarma EUDR?

Qarma's EUDR solution is the result of an extension to our already released tool Product Compliance (PC). PC already served some of the purposes of compliance with EUDR, and through the extension we will close the necessary gaps for full compliance.

The full EUDR solution is designed for furniture and interior companies who want to ease their administrative burden related to EUDR, by automating parts of the exercise information and documentation collection related to the due diligence requirements of the regulation.

How does your solution support different types of operations, such as import, trade, export, and domestic sourcing?

The system is designed to support both operators and traders with import or trade activities.

What is the engine, Qarma Product Compliance?

Qarma Product Compliance is an IT tool that simplifies and automates compliance documentation tasks. It manages repetitive actions such as requesting, collecting, storing, and tracking documents.

What processes do you have in place for handling risk mitigation?

Our system is designed to handle documentation of risk mitigation. It will suggest the forms of documentation needed and make room for direct upload by suppliers of said documents.

What approach do you take to collect, verify, and manage geolocation data?

Through the system, you request GeoJSON files from your supplier, who can upload the files directly in the system. Here, the system will analyse the file to make sure it follows the required format. If selected, the plots of land are automatically sent to our third-party provider, Satelligence, who will analyse the plots.

What kind of risk assessment or scoring capabilities does your solution include?

The solution follows the official EU country benchmarking to assign risk level as either low or high/standard. If the risk level is low, simplified due diligence is suggested through our standard requirements. If the risk level is high/standard full due diligence must be carried out. In this case, specific identified risks are assigned based on those listed in the Sourcing Hub developed by Preferred by Nature. Users are always able to customize their own documentation requirements in Qarma, should you want to go beyond simplified due diligence.

Can we export reference numbers and verification codes?

Yes, they can be exported in CSV/Excel files or passed on through APIs to ERP systems.

What kind of onboarding experience and support can new users expect when adopting your system?

All customers of Qarma, no matter what tool you purchase, will be assigned a project manager who will take you through a onboarding program. This will include a short series of meetings and configuration of your account. You will always have access to unlimited support from our team if any system-related questions or issues should come up.
